

Belfast Sprint Regatta

Course Notes

The Course is 500m, 2 Lane, Straight, Buoyed and Tidal. Starting at Stake boats at the Governors Bridge and finishing at Belfast Rowing Club.

Crews proceeding to the start from any slipway should stay close to the Co. Antrim bank and must not interfere with racing.

Follow the circulation pattern as noted by the arrows on this illustration.

Crews must stop at the 100m mark and await instructions to proceed through the Governors Bridge on the Co. Down side,

Please ensure that you launch in good time to report to the waiting area beyond the start, facing the start, at least 5 minutes before your race time.

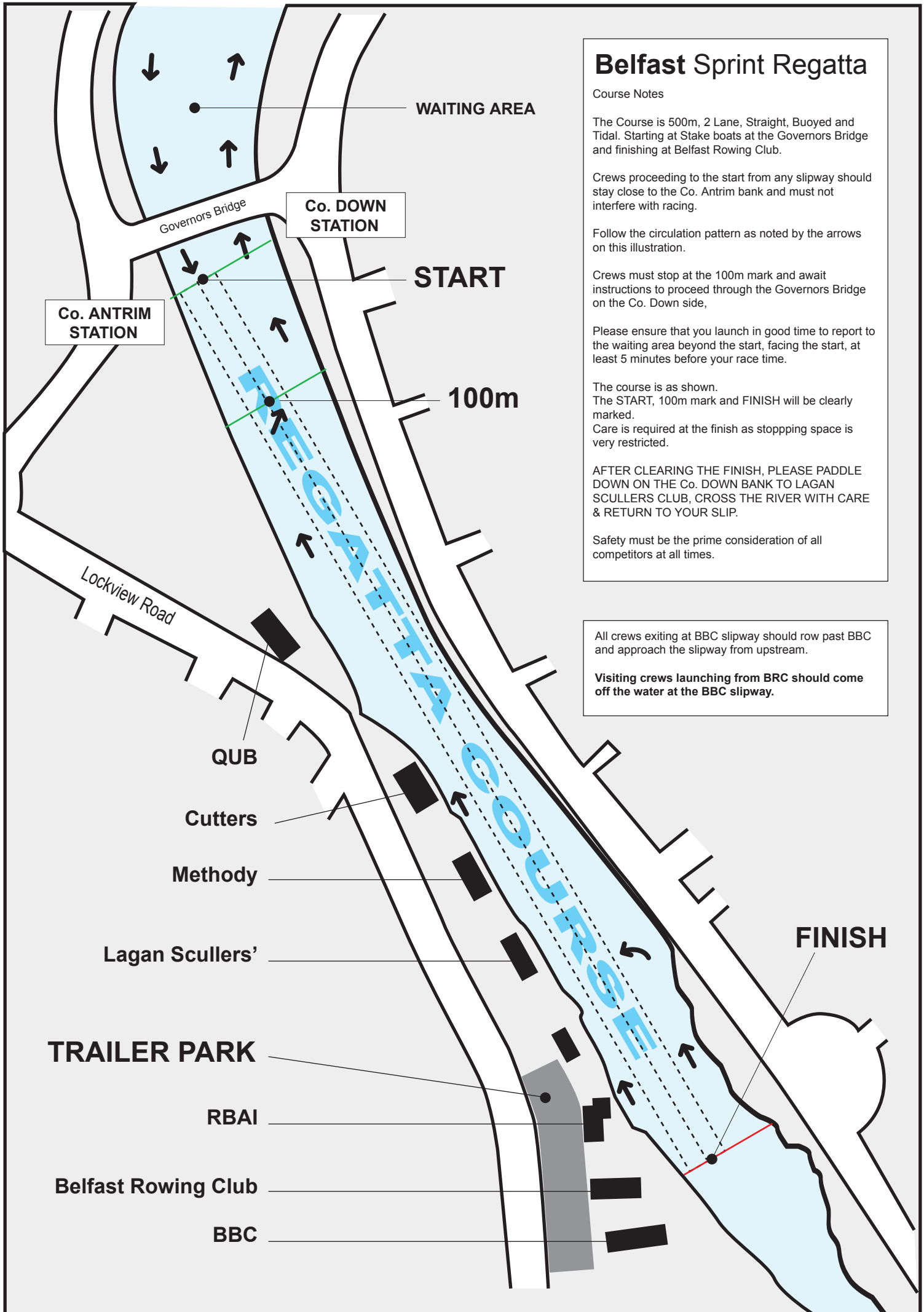
The course is as shown. The START, 100m mark and FINISH will be clearly marked. Care is required at the finish as stopping space is very restricted.

AFTER CLEARING THE FINISH, PLEASE PADDLE DOWN ON THE Co. DOWN BANK TO LAGAN SCULLERS CLUB, CROSS THE RIVER WITH CARE & RETURN TO YOUR SLIPWAY.

Safety must be the prime consideration of all competitors at all times.

All crews exiting at BBC slipway should row past BBC and approach the slipway from upstream.

Visiting crews launching from BRC should come off the water at the BBC slipway.
